ON EXHIBIT JULY 30TH TO OCTOBER 24TH

This year marks the 6th international biennial exhibition, sponsored by the Museum of Geometric and MADI art, which illustrates that the geometric idiom in contemporary art is as resilient as ever.

When the biennial call initially went out to artists, it was unclear whether the exhibition would happen at all, let alone in person due to Covid restrictions. For over a year now, artists around the world have had to adjust their studio practices, rearrange their lives, and rethink their work. For some this has been an introspective time taking stock of their practice, for others and their family, it has been personally traumatic; still others found new impetus for taking risks in new directions and media, and for a great many others, it has not radically changed their daily solitary studio routine. Regardless of how artists experienced the pandemic, those who answered the 2021 Biennial call did so with bold work and profound imagination.

The driving force in selecting work was to present a range of approaches and media and to engage a transnational dialogue between works hailing from different parts of the world. Entries were submitted from throughout the US as well as internationally from Latin America, Europe and Australia.

The 32 artists in this exhibition were selected based on creativity and concept of work but also with regard to assembling a cohesive exhibition displaying a diverse yet parallel expression of spatial concerns. The exhibition presents an array of paintings and sculptures assembled from an abundance of materials such as glass, steel, wood, felt, stone, and cardboard, as well as new technologies such as 3D printing.

Throughout the ages, from the refined complexity of Islamic patterning to the rigorous structures of contemporary Western art via ancient Greece and many other civilizations, geometry as a method of spatial organization in art has exerted a strong hold on visual culture. Today it continues to shine through transcultural generations of artists who feel compelled to engage with its vast lexicon. The exhibition demonstrates once again the extensive and international nature of geometric and MADI art, and its ongoing vitality in contemporary artistic practice.

This 2021 iteration of the Museum's biennial is supported by the City of Dallas, the Office of Cultural Affairs, the Texas Commission on the Arts, the National Endowment for the Arts and the Moody Fund for the Arts.

Special thanks to the Masterson family whose unwavering commitment and loyal support of geometric art has remained steadfast since the museum's opening over 18 years ago.












